

Construction on the Audubon Group B– Full Reconstruction, Patch Mill Overlay, Patched Concrete and Incidental Roadway Project is scheduled to begin in November 2021 and will last approximately 18 months. In general, the contractor will work from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday – Friday; however, there may be delays due to weather or other circumstances that cause the contractor to work later and / or on the weekends.

Residents should exercise caution when driving, bicycling or walking near active construction sites.





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The City of New Orleans and the Department of Public Works, in conjunction with the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans, will soon begin road repairs as part of the Audubon Group B—Patch Mill Overlay, Patch Concrete and Incidental Repairs.

Full Reconstruction, Patch Mill Overlay, Patch Concrete, and Incidental Repair projects are designed to:

- Replace damaged underground water, sewer and drainage lines;
- Repave the roadway;
- Replace damaged sidewalks and driveway aprons; and
- Install Americans with Disabilities Act-compliant curb ramps at intersections.
