Infrastructure By the Numbers

- More than **\$2.3B** worth of DPW / SWBNO work across the City
 - Includes FEMA-funded roadwork work via the approximately **\$2B** Joint Infrastructure (JIRR) Program
 - City-funded bond project work
- Nearly **200** individual projects -- every neighborhood will feel this positive impact
- Project schedules coordinated to minimize construction-related impacts
- Economic opportunity for the City's small and disadvantaged businesses

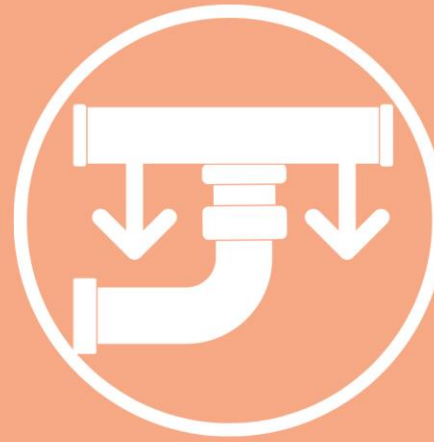

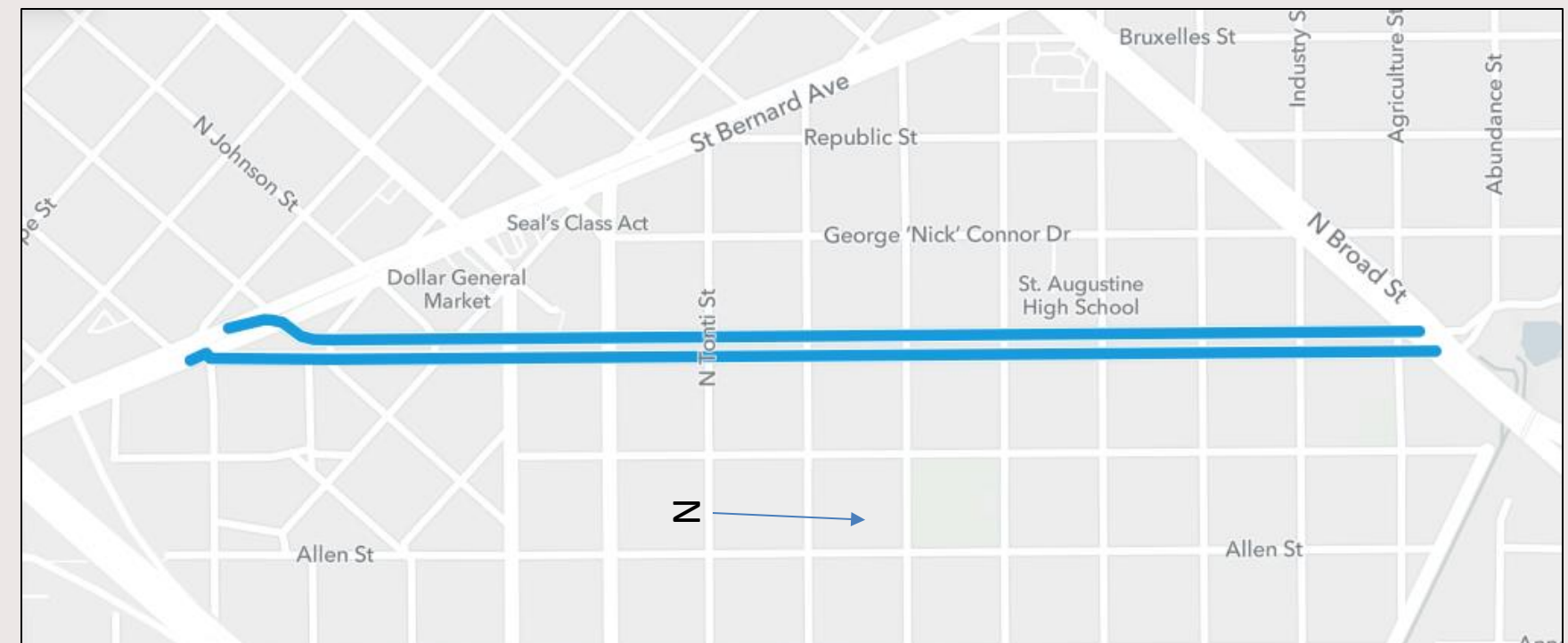

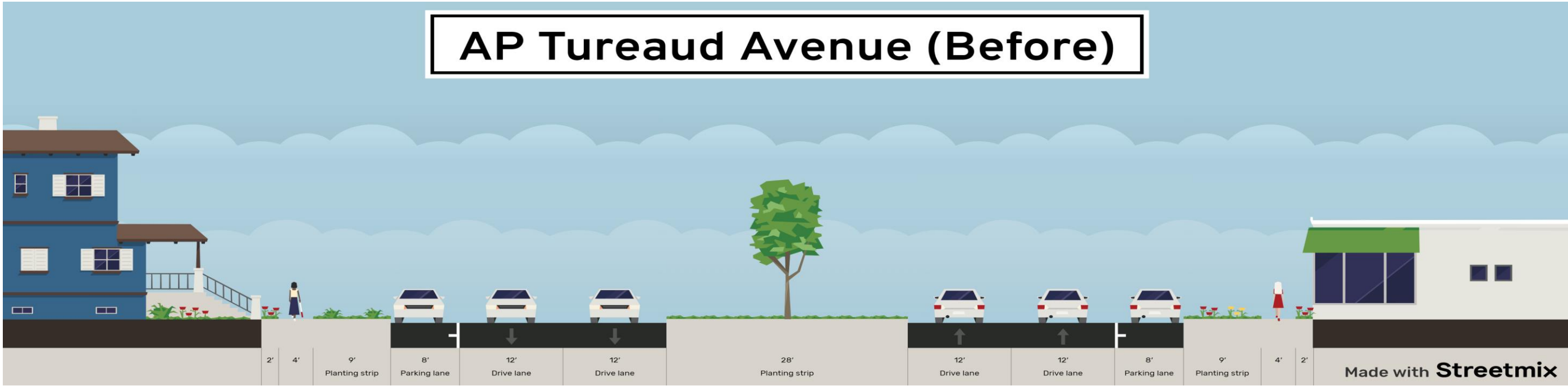
Why Streetscape Improvements on AP Tureaud Ave?

- City of New Orleans Complete Streets Policy (CAO Policy 134)
- Moving New Orleans Bicycle Blueprint (2020)
- Benefits include multimodal access, improved safety, connectivity, and equity, and less speeding
- This project includes high visibility crosswalks, protected bike lanes, and a travel lane reduction.
- Previous public presentations on this project occurred February 2, 2023 (Corpus Christi) and February 14, 2023 (City Council Transportation Committee Meeting)

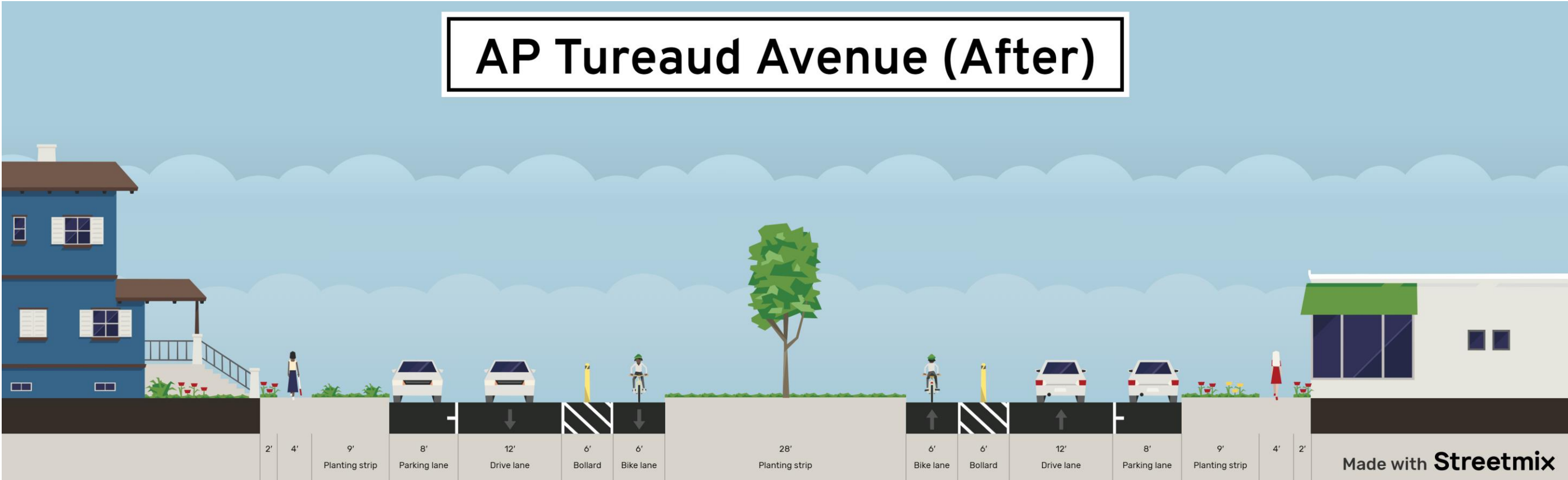

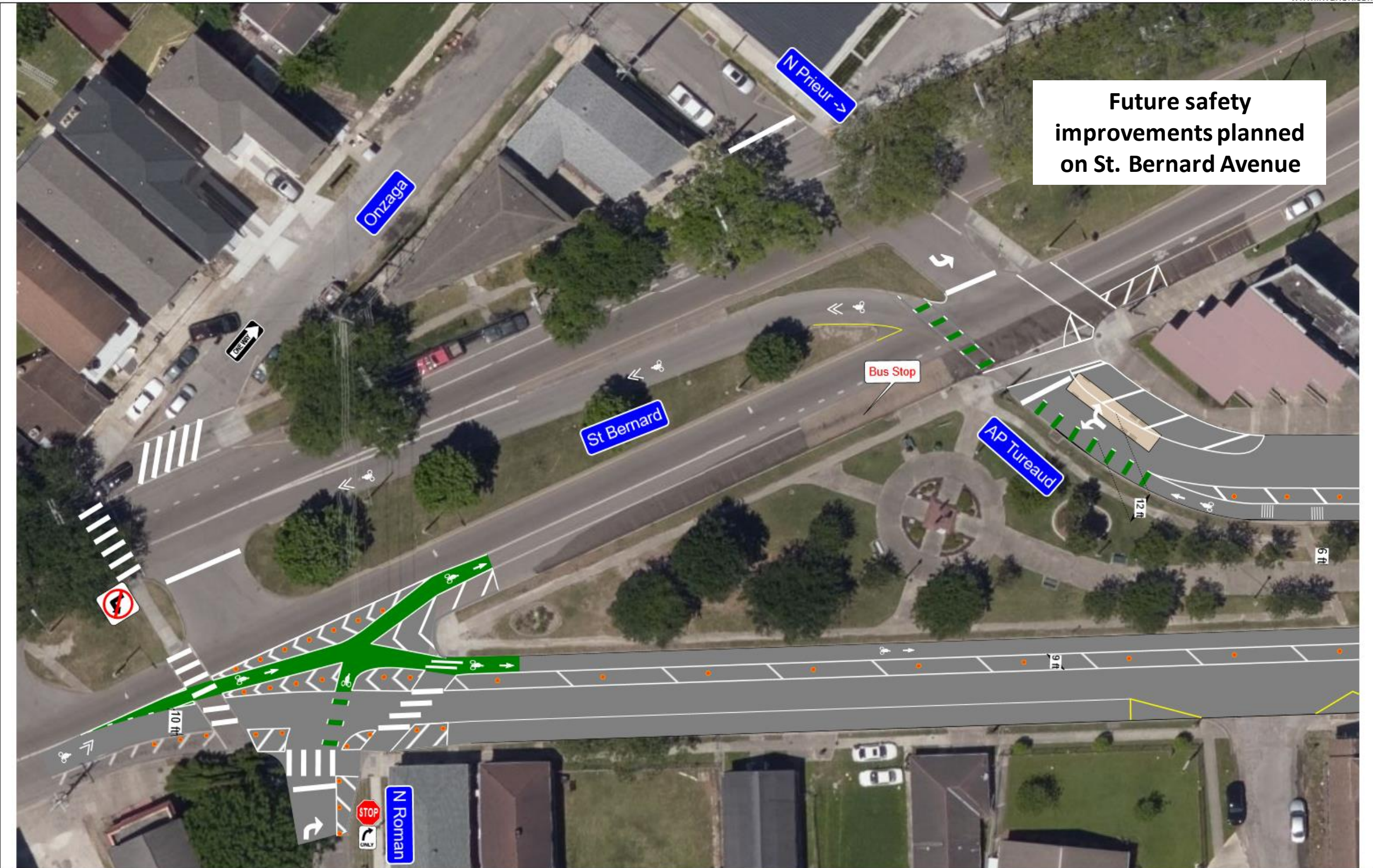

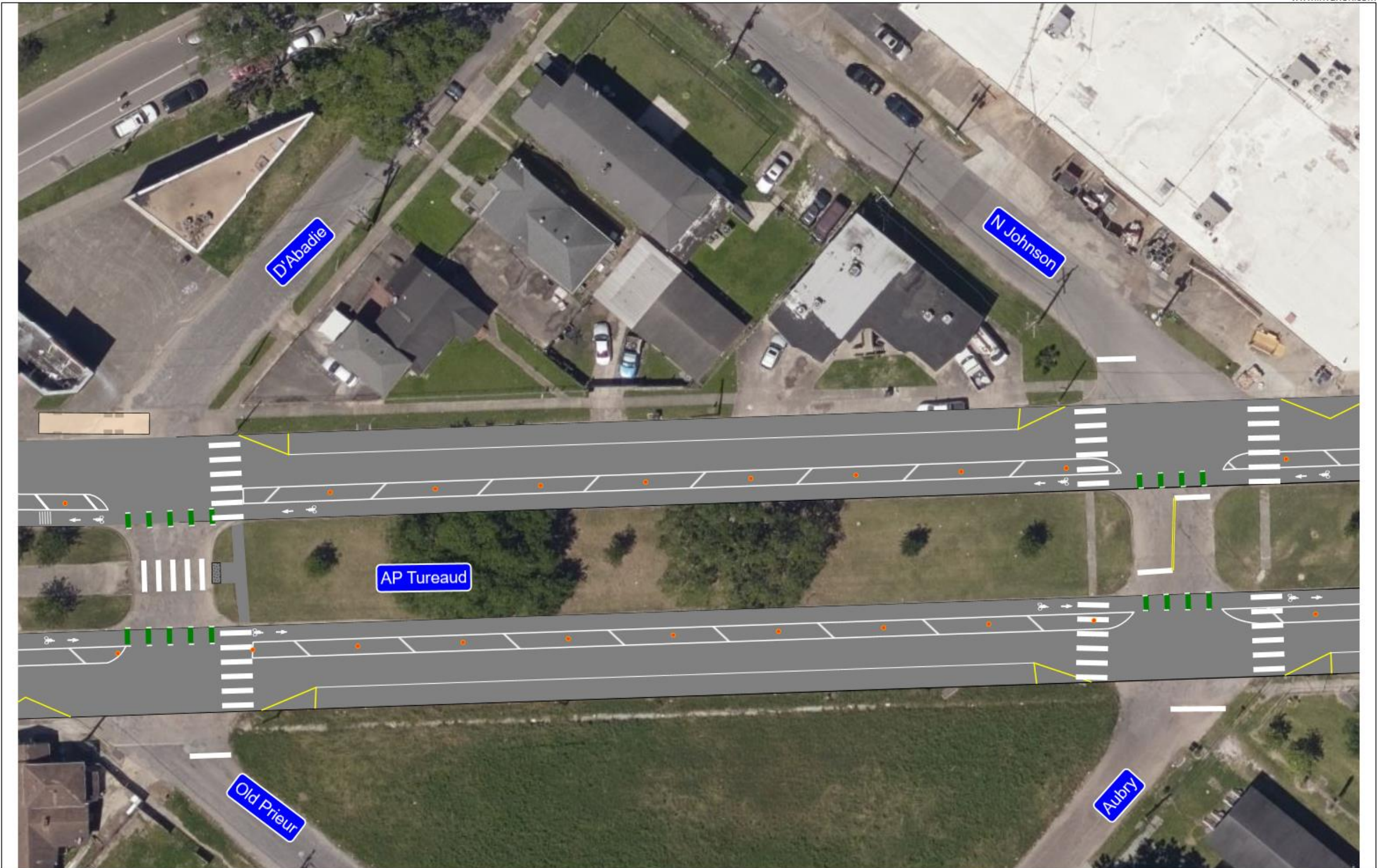


The protected bike lane on AP Tureaud Ave will resemble the protected bike lane on Wall Blvd.

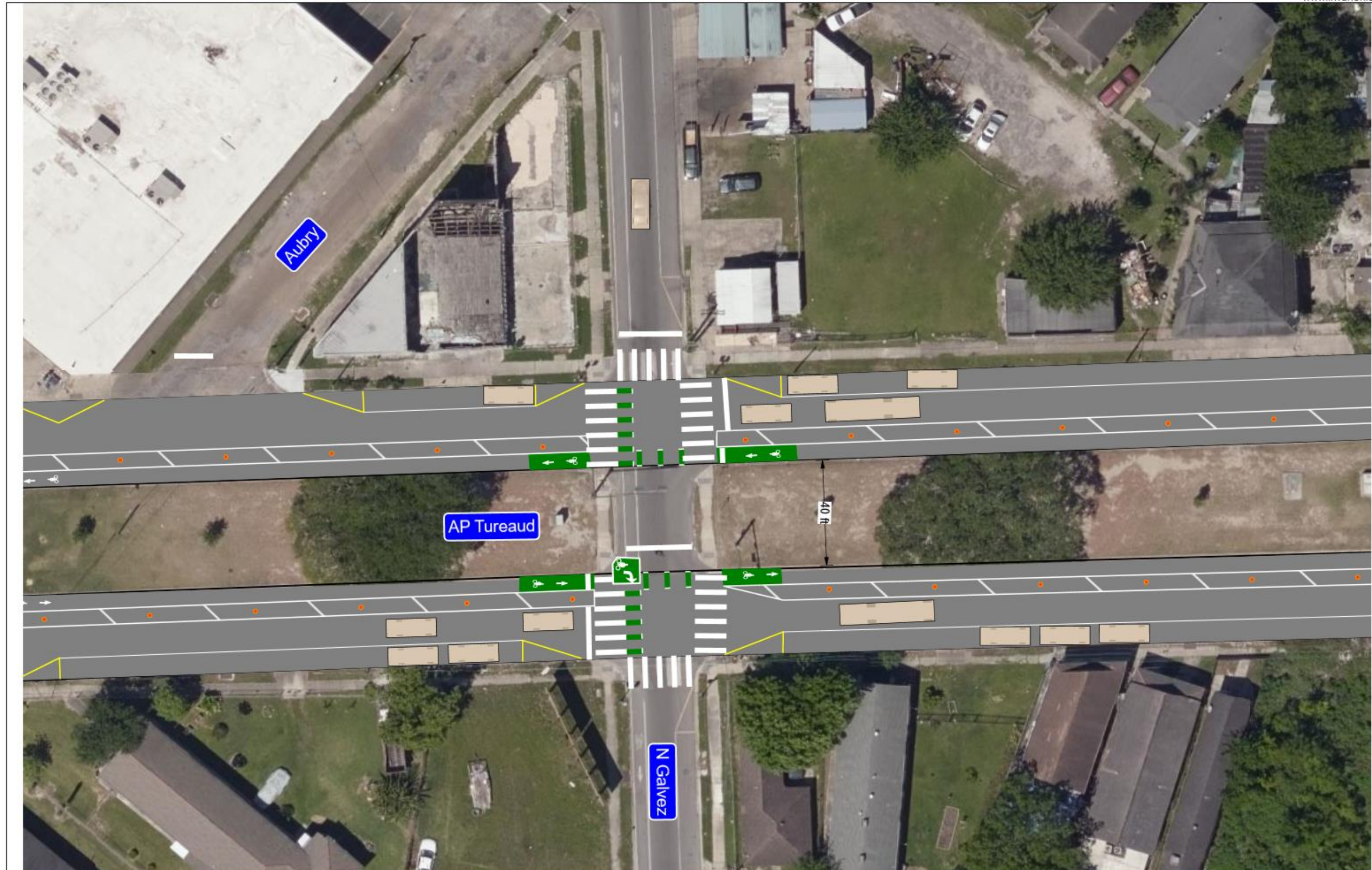

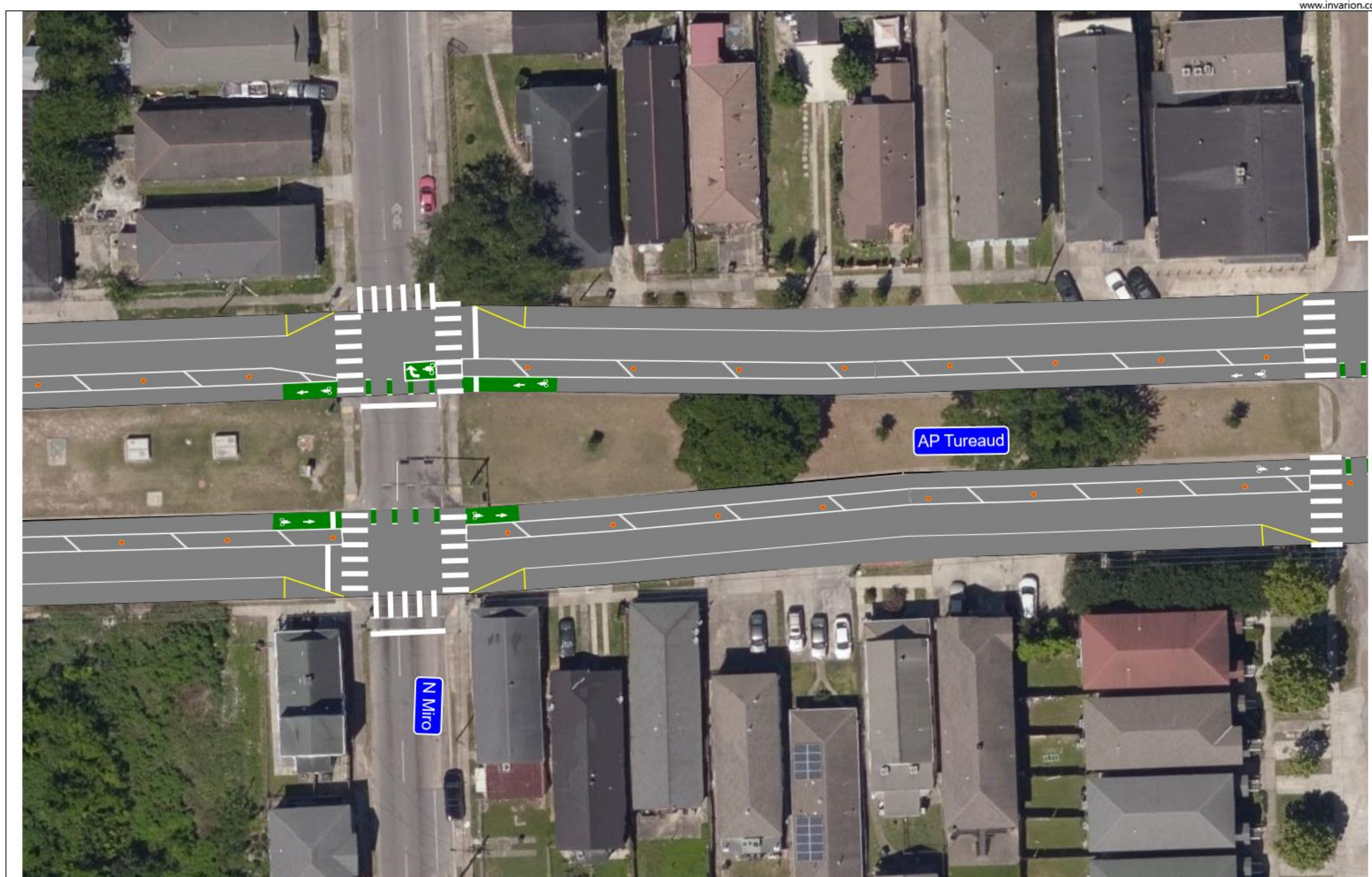
A.P. Tureaud Ave. (D'Abadie to Johnson)

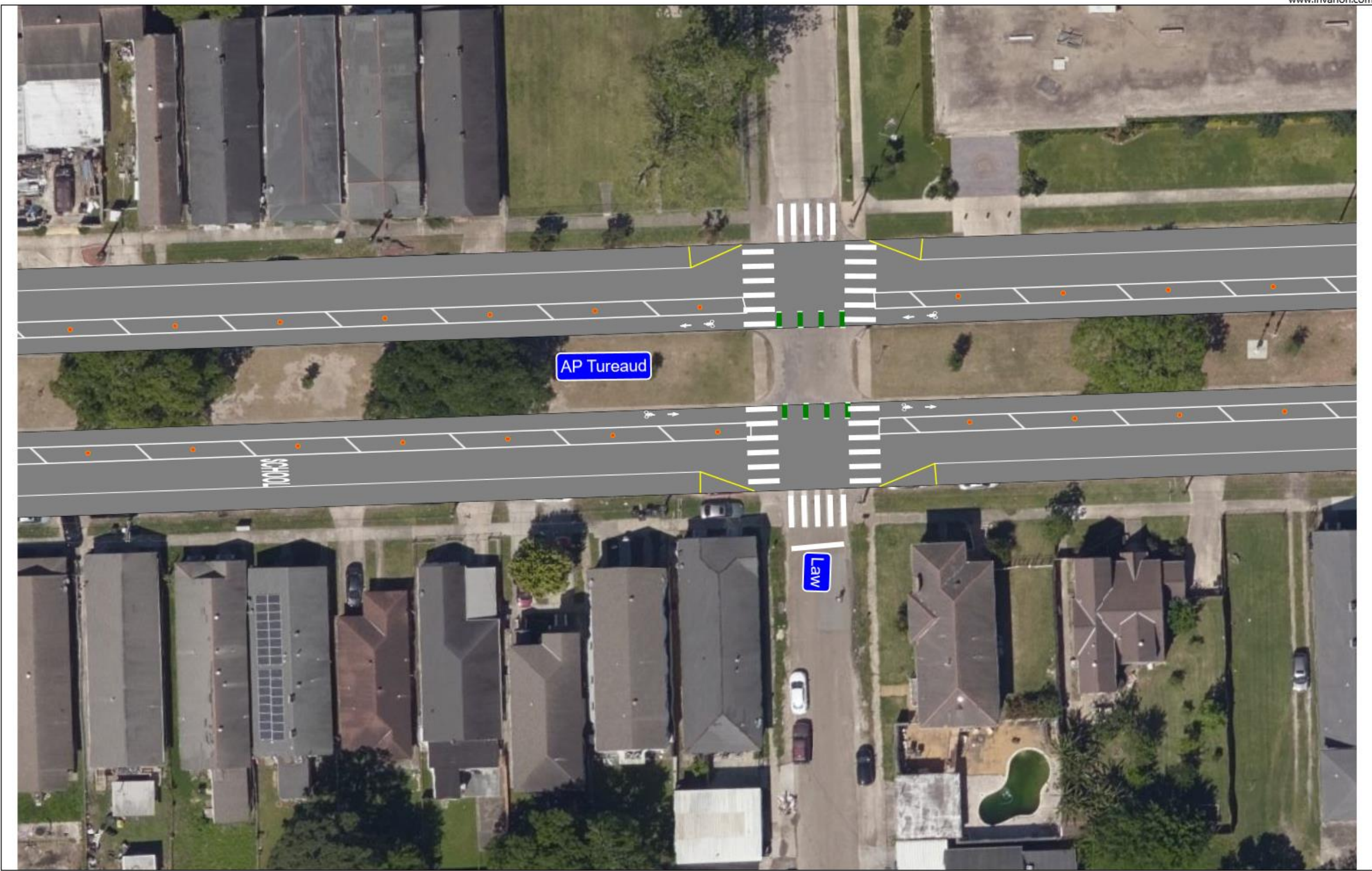

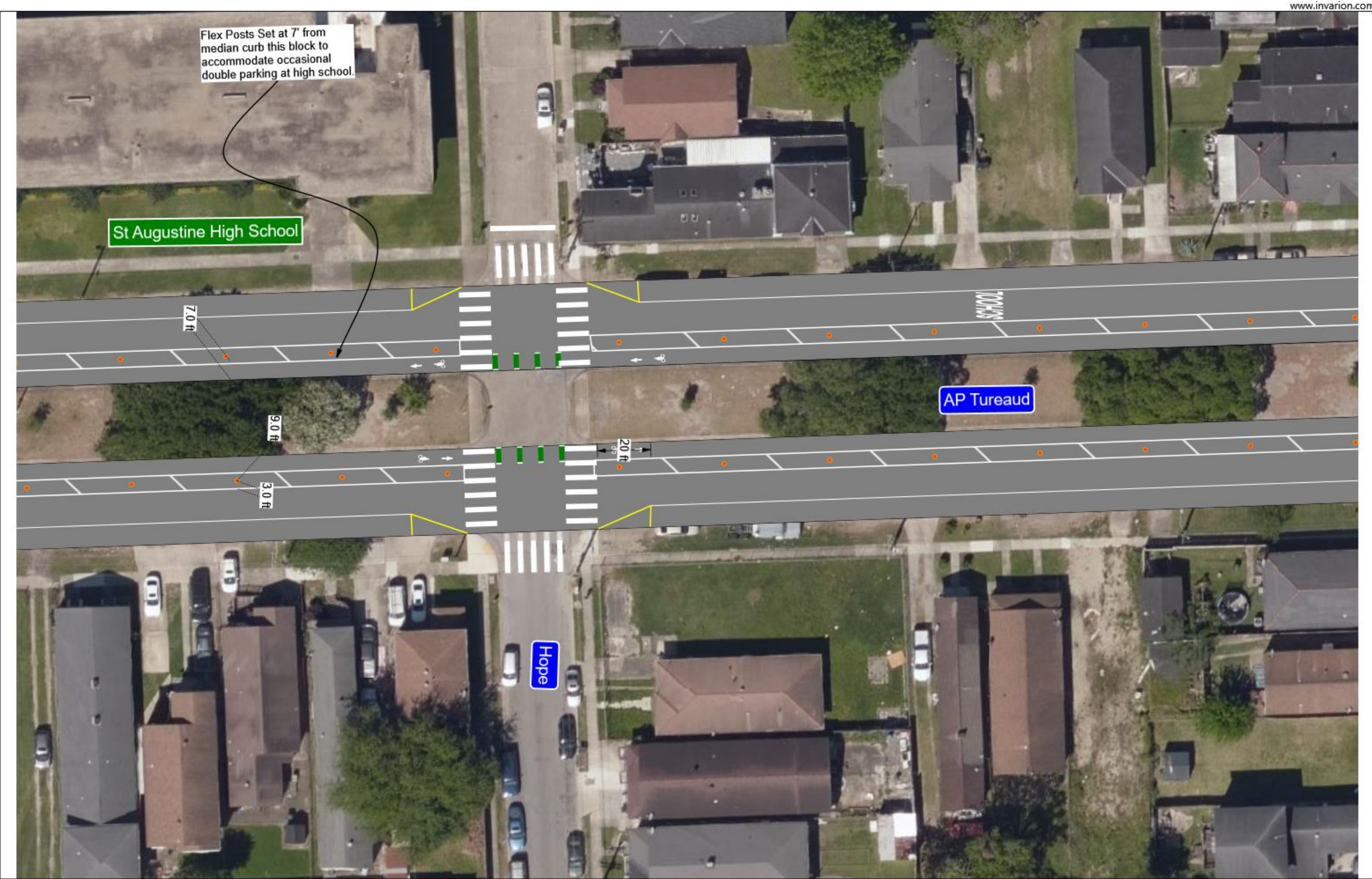

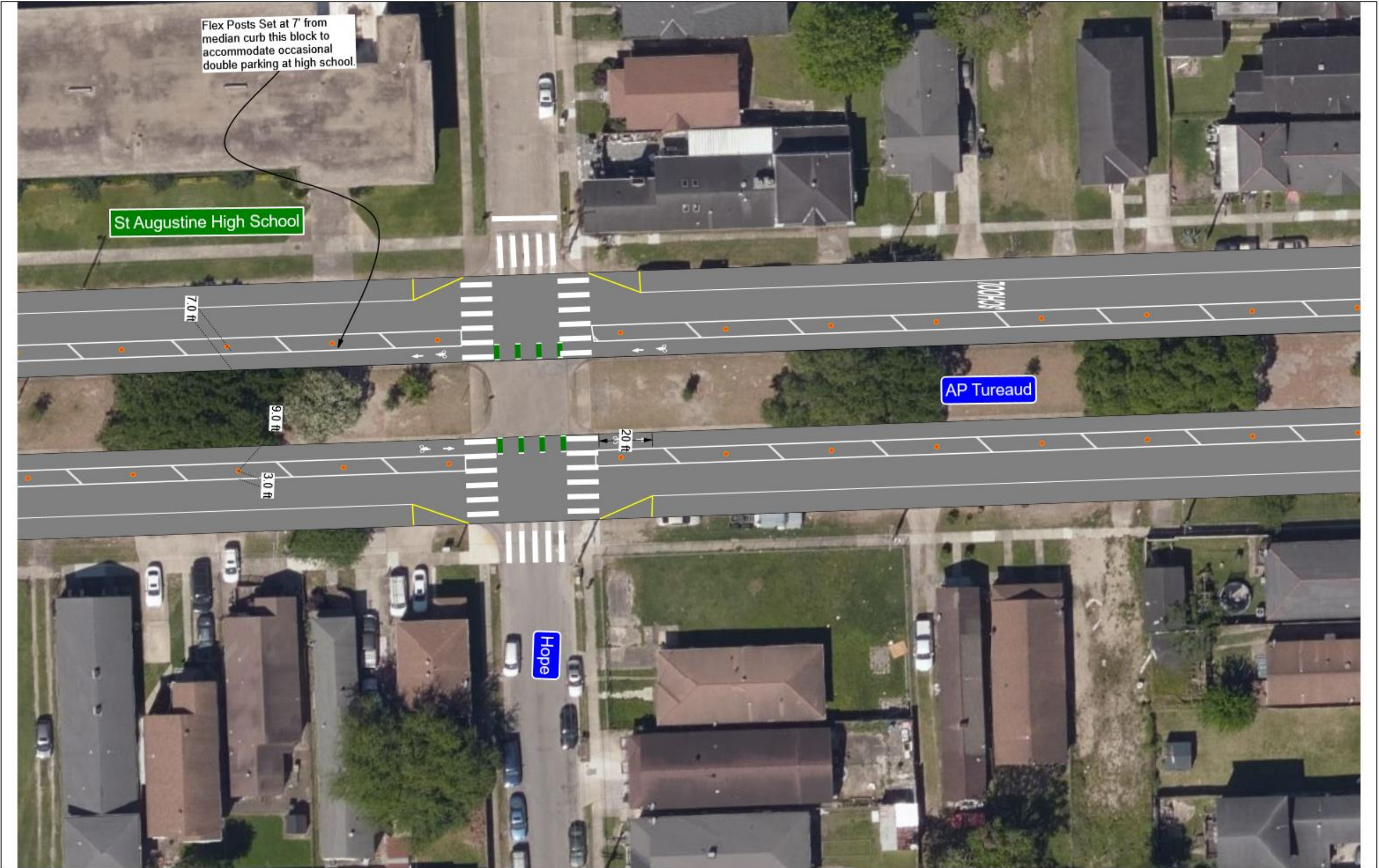
