Construction on the **Black Pearl/East Carrollton Group A — Patch Mill/Overlay and Incidental Road Repairs** project is scheduled to begin in August 2020 and will last approximately **12** months. In general, the contractor will work from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday – Friday; however, there may be delays due to weather or other circumstances that cause the contractor to work later and/or on weekends.

The City of New Orleans, Department of Public Works, in conjunction with the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans, will soon begin road repairs on the **Black Pearl/East Carrollton Group A — Patch Mill/Overlay and Incidental Road Repairs** project. These repairs include:

- Repaving the asphalt roadway from curb to curb;
- Patching the roadway with asphalt or concrete;
- Repairing damaged sidewalks and driveway aprons; and
- Installing Americans with Disabilities Act-compliant curb ramps at intersections.
