

Community Update – September 2023 Camp (Valmont-Jefferson), Chestnut/Coliseum (Valmont-Leontine), Leontine/Valmont (Mag-Prytania)

The Camp (Valmont-Jefferson), Chestnut/Coliseum (Valmont-Leontine), Leontine/Valmont (Mag-Prytania) project started in December 2022 and is a full reconstruction project that spans across 14-blocks from Magazine St. to Prytania St. When the project is complete, residents will have a new roadway, sidewalks, ADA ramps, and subsurface utilities.

Temporary inconveniences do tend to accompany infrastructure upgrades, and in this case, there have been delays. We are committed to holding all members of the team accountable to finding solutions for the issues holding up construction, as well as getting this work completed with an improved quality of life for the community.

30-Day Forecast

In order to remain on schedule weekend work may be performed to advance the progress of the project. **Residents will continue to be notified ahead of any weekend work.**

The Department of Public Works (DPW) and Palmisano Construction, LLC. are currently conducting work in the following areas:

- Utility Work
 - 5300 blocks of Camp
 - o 5300 blocks of Chestnut
- Paving Work, Sidewalk, & Driveway Work
 - o 1200 1300 blocks of Leontine

About the Project

This work is a part of the \$12.9M DPW018 Camp (Valmont-Jefferson), Chestnut/Coliseum (Valmont-Leontine), Leontine/Valmont (Mag-Prytania) joint infrastructure project with the City of New Orleans' Department of Public Works and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans.

Once complete, residents will experience an overall improved quality of life as the project will improve drainage, repair streets, curbs and sidewalks and install new Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)-compliant curb ramps at intersections. The project is scheduled to be completed in winter 2023.
