

Dillard Group A & B – August 2023 Community Update

The Dillard A/B project is a capital improvement project which includes various forms of construction throughout several Gentilly neighborhoods. The project spans across approximately 188 blocks with roadway restoration and subsurface utilities being addressed.

The project team would like to thank you for your continued patience. We understand the vast undertaking of construction in this area has come with temporary inconveniences, but we are on pace to complete this essential capital improvement project. The following is an update of upcoming construction throughout the project footprint.

What work is currently happening?

- Crews are working on roadway restoration on the following blocks: 400 of Warrington Dr, 4500 & 4700 blocks of Annette St, 2130 Foy St, 3900 Touro St, 4100 Frenchman St., 2100 & 2140 Pleasure St., and the 2100 block of Lafrieniere St.
- Additionally, ADA Ramps and sidewalks are being addressed on the following blocks: 300-400 Wallace Dr, 100-300 Warrington Dr, 2100 Pelopidas St, 2100 Mandolin St, 3950 Pauger St, and 3500 Touro St.
- Lastly, drainage crews completing repairs on the 1900 block of Pleasure St.

When will this project be completed?

• This project is currently scheduled to be completed by fall 2023.

About the Project

This work is a part of the \$39.5M RR215 Dillard Group A & B joint infrastructure project with the City of New Orleans' Department of Public Works and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans.

The project was designed by Gaea Consultants and is being constructed by Barriere Construction Company LLC. The scope of work varies block by block but includes the following:

- Repaving the asphalt roadway from curb-to-curb
- Replacing damaged portions of concrete with new concrete
- Patching the roadway with asphalt, repairing damaged sidewalks and driveway aprons
- Installing ADA compliant curb ramps at intersections
- Replacing/repairing damaged underground water, sewer and/or drainage line
