The City of New Orleans, Department of Public Works, in conjunction with the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans, will soon begin road repairs as part of the East Riverside/Garden District/Irish Channel/St. Thomas Group A Patch, Mill, Overlay and Incidental Road Repair project.

This project is designed to:

- Repave the asphalt roadway from curb-to-curb;
- Patch the roadway with asphalt or concrete;
- Repair damaged sidewalks and driveway aprons;
- Install Americans with Disabilities Act-compliant curb ramps at intersection; and
- Replace / repair damaged underground water, sewer, and/or drainage lines.
