



Project Update: **Gentilly Terrace Group E**

NOTICE OF WEEKEND WORK

To accelerate the completion of pavement restoration on Painters Street between Gentilly Boulevard and Mirabeau Avenue, the City of New Orleans' construction contractor, Barriere Construction, LLC, was scheduled to initiate work on Saturday, August 17, 2024. However, due to unforeseen equipment issues with their asphalt vendor, the paving scheduled to occur tomorrow is uncertain. If the asphalt company can get its equipment operational, paving will occur on Painters Street as planned. Unfortunately, the 4900 block of Painters will not be included in tomorrow's scope if paving occurs. We sincerely apologize for this situation.

WHEN: *Saturday, August 17th, from 7am – 5:30 pm*

WHERE: *Painters St (Gentilly Blvd – Mirabeau Ave)*

During this time there will be large trucks and heavy equipment hauling materials in the area. Public safety is our priority; residents and commuters are reminded to use caution when driving, bicycling and walking near the construction site.

About the Project

This weekend work is part of the approximately **\$10.2M Gentilly Terrace Group E** joint infrastructure project with the City of New Orleans' Department of Public Works and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans.

Once complete, residents will experience an overall improved quality of life as the project will improve drainage, repair streets, curbs and sidewalks and install new Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)-compliant curb ramps at intersections. The project is scheduled to be completed in summer 2024.
