

DPW672 Isaac Wave Drainage Project – September 2023 Community Update

The DPW672 Isaac Wave Project is a capital improvement project which includes various forms of construction throughout several neighborhoods in the city of New Orleans. The project spans across approximately 38-blocks with roadway restoration and subsurface utilities being addressed.

Temporary inconveniences do tend to accompany infrastructure upgrades; and while disruptions and delays have been minimal on this project, we will continue to remain accountable for finding solutions for any issues holding up construction. Our goal is to complete this work with an improved quality of life for the community. Following is an update and path forward on completing this project spring 2024.

What work is currently happening?

- Crews are completing sewer line repairs in the 2800 3000 blocks of Fortin St.
- Roadway restoration is underway on the 1100 Lyons St.
- Drainage line crews have begun repairs from the 1800 through 2000 blocks of Palmer Ave.

When will this project be completed?

• This project is currently scheduled to be completed by Spring 2024.

About the Project

This \$10.5M DPW672 Isaac Wave Drainage project began in April 2023. Project construction is being completed by Murphy Pipeline Construction, LLC. The scope of work varies from block to block but includes the following:

- Repaving the asphalt roadway from curb-to-curb
- Replacing damaged portions of concrete with new concrete
- Patching the roadway with asphalt, repairing damaged sidewalks and driveway aprons
- Installing ADA compliant curb ramps at intersections
- Replacing/repairing damaged underground water, sewer and/or drainage line
