



## Project Update: **Lake Vista Group D**

### **NOTICE OF SERVICE DISRUPTION**

**\*\* WATER \*\***

**You may experience low or no water pressure in this area.**

During this time, please find an alternative water supply.

The City of New Orleans Department of Public Works' contractor Roubion Roads and Streets, LLC, in conjunction with the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans, will be performing a waterline tie-in.

**WHEN:** Tuesday, January 21<sup>st</sup>, 2025, from 8AM – 5PM

**WHERE:** Crane St (Allen Toussaint Blvd – Foliage Park)

**When water is restored, run your faucets for 5 minutes to flush out the lines before resuming regular use.**

If water is not restored within one hour after end time on January 21<sup>st</sup>, residents will be contacted by the office of Strategic Engagement and Special Projects and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans via text messaging alert and/or community canvassing.

### **About the Project**

This temporary disruption of services is part of the **\$12.7M Lake Vista Group D** joint infrastructure project with the City of New Orleans' Department of Public Works and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans.

Once complete, residents will experience an overall improved quality of life as the project will improve roadways and subsurface utilities. The project is scheduled to be completed in the Spring 2025.
