



Project Update: Lakeview South B February 22, 2024

NOTICE OF SERVICE DISRUPTION ** WATER **

You may experience low or no water pressure in this area.

During this time, please find an alternative water supply.

The City of New Orleans Department of Public Works' contractor Hard Rock Construction, LLC., in conjunction with the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans, will be performing a valve test closure.

WHEN: Tuesday February 27, 2024, from 1:00p.m. – 5:00p.m.

WHERE: Marshal Foch St. (Brooks St. to Harrison Ave.)

Germain St. (Marshal Foch St. to Argonne Blvd.)

When water is restored, run your faucets for 5 minutes to flush out the lines before resuming regular use.

If water is not restored by one hour after closure ends on Tuesday February 27, 2024, residents will be contacted by RoadworkNOLA and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans via text messaging alert and/or community canvassing.

About the Project

This temporary disruption of services is part of the \$18.4M Lakeview South Group B joint infrastructure project with the City of New Orleans' Department of Public Works and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans.

Once complete, residents will experience an overall improved quality of life as the project will improve roadways and subsurface utilities. The project is scheduled to be completed in the Fall 2024.
