NOTICE OF SERVICE DISRUPTION ** WATER **

You may experience low or no water pressure in this area.

During this time, please find an alternative water supply.

The City of New Orleans Department of Public Works' contractor Hard Rock Construction, LLC., in conjunction with the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans, will be performing a water tie-in.

WHEN: Thursday February 8, 2024, from 8:30a.m. – 4:30p.m.

WHERE: Marshal Foch St. (Harrison Ave. to Brooks St.)

Brooks St. (General Diaz St. to Argonne Blvd.)

Germain St. (General Diaz St. to Argonne Blvd.)

When water is restored, run your faucets for 5 minutes to flush out the lines before resuming regular use.

If water is not restored within one hour after the closure ends on Thursday February 8, 2024, residents will be contacted by RoadworkNOLA and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans via text messaging alert and/or community canvassing.

About the Project

This temporary disruption of services is part of the \$18.4M Lakeview South Group B joint infrastructure project with the City of New Orleans' Department of Public Works and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans.

Once complete, residents will experience an overall improved quality of life as the project will improve roadways and subsurface utilities. The project is scheduled to be completed in the Fall 2024.
