

Construction on the Marlyville-Fontainebleau Group A Patch, Mill, Overlay, Incidental Road Repair, and Full-Depth Reconstruction Project is scheduled to begin between June and July 2021 and will last approximately **21** months. In general, the contractor will work from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday – Friday; however, there may be delays due to weather or other circumstances that cause the contractor to work later and / or on the weekends.

Residents should exercise caution when driving, bicycling or walking near active construction sites.



The City of New Orleans, Department of Public Works, in conjunction with the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans, will soon begin road repairs as part of the Marlyville-Fontainebleau Group A Patch, Mill, Overlay, Incidental Road Repair, and Full-Depth Reconstruction project. This project is designed to:

- Repave the asphalt roadway from curb-to-curb;
- Patch the roadway with asphalt or concrete;
- Repair damaged sidewalks and driveway aprons;
- Install Americans with Disabilities Act-compliant curb ramps at intersection; and
- Replace / repair damaged underground water, sewer, and/or drainage lines.
