

Community Update – June 2023 Marlyville-Fontainebleau Group C

Marlyville-Fontainebleau Group C is a full reconstruction project in the Marlyville and Fontainebleau neighborhoods. The project spans across approximately 23 blocks, with 19 of the blocks being fully reconstructed, with subsurface utility work.

Temporary inconveniences do tend to accompany infrastructure upgrades; however, in this case, the delays and access issues have been excessive. In recent months, leaders from the City Infrastructure Team have been conducting site visits and working closely with the combined Sewerage and Water Board New Orleans (SWBNO) / Department of Public Works (DPW) project management and construction contractor team. We are committed to holding all members of the team accountable to finding solutions for the issues holding up construction, as well as to getting this work completed with an improved quality of life for the community. Following is an update and path forward on completing this project with minimal delays. Marlyville-Fontainebleau Group C is scheduled to be completed by end of summer 2023.

30-Day Forecast

Due to delays on this project crews will continue to work some weekends to meet critical deadlines outlined in this update. *Residents will continue to be notified ahead of any weekend work.*

Roadway restoration at 3000 Carrollton (from Fig St. to Earhart Blvd.) has begun and will be completed by the beginning August, weather permitting. The intersection of State Street Dr. and Fontainebleau Ave. will be completed along with the wearing course mobilization of 3000 S. Carrollton. Panama Ct. roadway restoration is currently underway and will be completed by the end of August. Walmsley Ave. (between Versailles and State Street Dr.) will be completed by the end of August as well.

This **\$10.5M** Marlyville-Fontainebleau Group C project began September 2020. This project was designed by Schrenk, Endom & Flanagan and is being constructed by Wallace C. Drennan Inc. The scope of work varies block by block but includes the following:

- Scope of work includes replacing damaged underground water, sewer, and drainage lines
- Repaving the roadway
- Replacing damaged sidewalks and driveway aprons
- Installing ADA compliant curb ramps at intersections.
