

Construction on the Marlyville-Fontainebleau Group C - Full Depth Reconstruction Project is scheduled to begin in September 2020 and will last approximately 17 months. In general, the contractor will work from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday – Friday; however, there may be delays due to weather or other circumstances that cause the contractor to work later and / or on the weekends.

Residents should exercise caution when driving, bicycling or walking near active construction sites.





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The City of New Orleans, Department of Public Works, in conjunction with the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans, will soon begin road repairs as part of the Marlyville-Fontainebleau Group C Full-Depth Reconstruction project.

Full-Depth Reconstruction projects are designed to:

- Replace damaged underground water, sewer and drainage lines;
- Repave the roadway;
- Replace damaged sidewalks and driveway aprons; and
- Install Americans with Disabilities Act-compliant curb ramps at intersections.
