



Community Update – August 2023

Marlyville Fontainebleau Group H

Marlyville Fontainebleau Group H project is a full reconstruction in the Marlyville Fontainebleau neighborhood. The project spans across approximately 8 blocks with both surface and subsurface utility work.

Temporary inconveniences do tend to accompany infrastructure upgrades; however, in this case, the delays and access issues have been minimal. We are committed to holding all members of the team accountable to finding solutions for any issues that may arise during construction, as well as to getting this work completed with an improved quality of life for the community. Following is an update and path forward on completing this project winter 2024.

30-Day Forecast

Project crews will continue to work some weekends to meet critical deadlines outlined in this update. **Residents will continue to be notified ahead of any weekend work.**

The Department of Public Works (DPW), Sewerage Water Board of New Orleans (SWBNO), and Murphy Pipeline Construction, LLC. are scheduled to complete subsurface utility repairs on the following blocks over the next 30 days:

- S. Galvez St. (Nashville Ave. to Jefferson Ave.)
- State Street Dr. (S. Claiborne Ave to Fontainebleau Dr.)

The Construction Team is scheduled to complete roadway restoration on the following blocks by the end of August 2023, weather pending:

- 5800 S. Galvez St.
- 5800 McKenna St.
- 6300 S. Rocheblave St.

The project team is completing full reconstruction throughout the project footprint. The construction team will work in phases addressing all subsurface utilities and then finishing with restoration of the roadway. The community is notified as we move through various phases to stay abreast of current and upcoming construction. The pipe bursting method has received positive feedback from the residents and proved to be an effective means of construction for the area.

This **\$15.9M** Marlyville Fontainebleau Group H project began in April 2023. The project was designed by Design Engineering, Inc and is being constructed by Murphy Pipeline Construction. The scope of work varies block by block but includes the following:

- Replacement of damaged underground water, sewer and drainage lines;
- Repaving the roadways;
- Replacing damaged sidewalks and driveway aprons; and
- Installing Americans with Disabilities Act-compliant curb ramps at intersections.
