

Construction on the Martin Luther King Blvd (St. Charles - S. Claiborne) - Patch Mill Overlay project is scheduled to begin in May 2022 and will last approximately 14 months. In general, the contractor will work from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday – Friday; however, there may be delays due to weather or other circumstances that cause the contractor to work later and / or on the weekends.

Residents should exercise caution when driving, bicycling or walking near active construction sites.





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The City of New Orleans and the Department of Public Works, will soon begin road repairs as part of the Martin Luther King Blvd. (St. Charles - S. Claiborne) - Patch Mill Overlay project. The project will include a vehicular lane reduction and parking lane shift between St. Charles Ave. and Clara St. in the lakebound direction of Martin Luther King Blvd. and a vehicular lane reduction and parking lane shift between St. Charles Ave. and S. Robertson St. in the riverbound direction of Martin Luther King Blvd. to provide protected bike lanes in both directions of travel.

Patch Mill Overlay projects are designed to:

- Repave the roadway;
- Replace damaged sidewalks and driveway aprons; and
- Install Americans with Disabilities Act-compliant curb ramps at intersections.
