

Community Update – September 2023 Mid-City Group B

The Mid-City Group B project is a patch mill overlay project in the Mid-City neighborhood. The project spans across approximately 111-blocks with 4 blocks being full reconstruction of the roadway and subsurface utilities.

Temporary inconveniences do tend to accompany infrastructure upgrades; however, in this case, the delays and access issues have been excessive. Leaders from the City Infrastructure Team have been conducting site visits and working closely with the combined Sewerage and Water Board New Orleans (SWBNO) / Department of Public Works (DPW) project management and construction contractor team. We are committed to holding all members of the team accountable to finding solutions for the issues holding up construction, as well as to getting this work completed with an improved quality of life for the community. The following is an update and path forward on completing this project with minimal delays by the anticipated Fall 2023 end date.

30-Day Forecast

Due to delays on this project crews will continue to work some weekends to meet critical deadlines outlined in this update. *Residents will be notified ahead of any weekend work.*

The Department of Public Works (DPW) and Hard Rock Construction, LLC. are scheduled to complete roadway restoration on the following blocks, weather pending:

- 100 N. & S Scott St.
- 400 S. Genois St.
- 300 & 600 S. Rendon St.
- 500 S. Gayoso St. & Tulane Ave.
- 600 & 700 S. Lopez St.

This **\$24.4M** Mid-City Group B project was designed by Infinity Engineering, Inc and is being constructed by Hard Rock Construction. The scope of work varies block by block but includes the following:

- Replacement of damaged underground water, sewer and drainage lines;
- Repaving the roadways;
- Replacing damaged sidewalks and driveway aprons; and
- Installing Americans with Disabilities Act-compliant curb ramps at intersections.
