

Construction on the Mid-City Group B Patch, Mill, Overlay and **Incidental Road Repair Project** is scheduled to begin in March 2021 and will last approximately 18 months. In general, the contractor will work from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday – Friday; however, there may be delays due to weather or other circumstances that cause the contractor to work later and / or on the weekends.

Residents should exercise caution when driving, bicycling or walking near active construction sites.





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The City of New Orleans, Department of Public Works, in conjunction with the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans, will soon begin road repairs as part of the Mid-City Group B Patch, Mill, Overlay and Incidental Road Repair project.

This project is designed to:

- Repave the asphalt roadway from curb-to-curb;
- Patch the roadway with asphalt or concrete;
- Repair damaged sidewalks and driveway aprons;
- Install Americans with Disabilities Act-compliant curb ramps at intersection; and
 - Replace / repair damaged underground water, sewer, and/or drainage lines.
