



Project Update: Mirabeau Water Garden Phase 1

NOTICE OF WEEKEND WORK

The City of New Orleans construction contractor, M.R. Pittman Group, LLC, will be continuing work within the Pump Station this Saturday in an effort to remain on schedule. Crews will be preparing the ramp and foundation work ahead of electric & pumping installation within the pumphouse.

WHEN: *Saturday, November 23rd, 2024, 7 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.*

WHERE: Within the Mirabeau Water Garden grounds

During this time there will be large trucks and heavy equipment hauling materials in the area. Public safety is our priority; residents and commuters are reminded to use caution when driving, bicycling and walking near the construction site.

About the Project

This temporary disruption is part of the **\$30 M Mirabeau Water Garden – Phase 1** joint infrastructure project with the City of New Orleans' Department of Public Works and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans.

Once complete, residents will experience an overall improved quality of life as the project will improve subsurface drainage capacity between local streets and trunk lines and install green infrastructure such as retention/detention basins and bioswales. This work is part of the FEMA funded Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP)'s Leveraged Gray / Green Infrastructure projects and is scheduled to be completed in Fall 2025.
