



Project Update: Oak Park Drainage Upgrades August 18th, 2023 **NOTICE OF WEEKEND WORK**

The City of New Orleans construction contractor, Cycle Construction Company, LLC, will be performing backfill work on the stormwater tank along Perlita St. this Saturday, August 19th, 2023, in an effort to remain on schedule.

WHEN: Saturday August 19th, 2023, 7 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.

WHERE: Perlita St (Aviators St – Burbank Dr)

During this time there will be large trucks and heavy equipment hauling materials in the area. Public safety is our priority; residents and commuters are reminded to use caution when driving, bicycling and walking near the construction site.

About the Project

This Holiday work is part of the **\$5.3M Oak Park Drainage Upgrades** joint infrastructure project with the City of New Orleans' Department of Public Works and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans.

Once complete, residents will experience an overall improved quality of life as the project will improve subsurface drainage capacity between local streets and trunk lines and install green infrastructure such as retention/detention basins and bioswales. This work is part of the FEMA funded Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP)'s Leveraged Gray / Green Infrastructure projects and is scheduled to be completed in Fall 2023.
