
Capital Improvement Program Highlights


More than \$2.2B worth of combined DPW / SWBNO work

- Most comprehensive infrastructure program our region has seen in a generation.
- More than 200 individual projects every neighborhood will feel a positive impact.
- Multiple Funding Sources: FEMA-funded road / waterline work, FEMA-funded Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) projects, HUD-funded National Disaster Resiliency Competition (NDRC) grant projects, SWB-funded Sewer System Evaluation and Rehabilitation Program (SSERP) (sewer consent decree) work and City-funded bond project work.
- Work will create thousands of construction jobs across the city and <u>maximize economic opportunity</u> for the City's small and disadvantaged





Project Overview: Read Blvd East Group B

- Construction Cost: Approximately \$3.6 M Project
- Timeline: Project will begin January 2020 and will be completed in December 2020.



Project Overview: Read Blvd East Group C

Design:

Barowka and Bonura Engineers and Consultants, LLC

- Construction: Palmisano
- Construction Cost: Approximately \$3.3 M Project
- Timeline: Project will begin January 2020 and will be completed in December 2020.



Scope of work:

- Replacing damaged portions of concrete with new concrete;
- Repairing damaged sidewalks and driveway aprons;
- Installing Americans with Disabilities Act-compliant curb ramps at intersections; and
- Replacing/ repairing damaged underground water, sewer and/ or drainage lines.



Waterline Replacements or Repairs

 Notifications will be sent to residents 48-hours prior to any work that may cause water services disruptions



Patch Mill / Overlay



- Re-surfacing the roadway with asphalt
- Repairing damaged curbs, sidewalks and driveway aprons





Patch Concrete

- Replacing one or multiple damaged concrete panels in the roadway
- Repairing damaged curbs, sidewalks and driveway aprons








Sidewalks

- Replacing sidewalk panels adjacent to Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)compliant ramps will be replaced with new sidewalks.
- New sidewalks and ramps will meet ADA-compliance regulations.








Americans with Disabilities Act-Compliant Curb Ramps




Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)-compliant curb ramps at sidewalk corners ensure accessibility for people who are visually or physically impaired, using wheelchairs or strollers.

What to Expect During Construction


Temporary construction impacts

- Additional construction equipment
- Limited parking availability
- Sounds
- Dust

Efforts to minimize construction impacts

- Construction signage placed around the sites.
- ✓ Any temporary closures will be communicated in advance.
- Construction equipment will not be staged in areas that prohibit residential access and parking.
- Any changes to garbage and US Postal services will be communicated in advance.
- Residents will be informed throughout construction.

Regular work hours are Monday-Friday 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Permission for occasional weekend work may be granted, if required.
