



Project Update: St. Roch Drainage Upgrades Project September 12th, 2024 **NOTICE OF WEEKEND WORK**

The City of New Orleans' Office of Stormwater & Green Infrastructure contractor, Command Construction Industries Company, LLC in conjunction with the Department of Public Works & the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans will continue clean-up efforts after Hurricane Francine and resume construction work in an effort to remain on schedule.

During this time there will be large trucks and heavy equipment hauling materials in the area. Public safety is our priority; residents and commuters are reminded to use caution when driving, bicycling and walking near the construction site. As this work is being completed, sections of the roadway may be closed to vehicle traffic due to construction. Signage will be posted.

About the Project

This temporary inconvenience is part of the **\$18.5 M St. Roch Drainage Upgrades** joint infrastructure project with the City of New Orleans' Department of Public Works and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans.

Once complete, residents will experience an overall improved quality of life as the project will improve subsurface drainage capacity between local streets and trunk lines and install green infrastructure such as retention/detention basins and bioswales. This work is part of the FEMA funded Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP)'s Leveraged Gray / Green Infrastructure projects and is scheduled to be completed in Fall 2024.
