**NOTICE OF SERVICE DISRUPTION**  
**\*\* WATER \*\***

**You may experience low or no water pressure in this area.**  
During this time, please find an alternative water supply.

The City of New Orleans Department of Public Works' contractor Command Construction Industries, LLC., in conjunction with the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans, Waterlines between Franklin and St. Roch will be swapped over.

**WHEN:** *Tuesday, August 15, 2023, 8:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.*

**WHERE:** 2200-2500 BLOCKS OF NORTH VILLERE ST  
1300-1400 MARIGNY ST  
1300-1400 MANDEVILLE ST  
1300-1400 SPAIN ST  
1300-1400 MUSIC ST  
1300-1400 ARTS ST

**When water is restored, run your faucets for 5 minutes to flush out the lines before resuming regular use.**

**If water is not restored within one hour on August 15, 2023 residents will be contacted by RoadworkNOLA and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans via text messaging alert and/or community canvassing.**

**About the Project**

This temporary disruption of services is part of the **\$18.1 M St. Roch Drainage Upgrades** joint infrastructure project with the City of New Orleans' Department of Public Works and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans.

Once complete, residents will experience an overall improved quality of life as the project will improve subsurface drainage capacity between local streets and trunk lines and install green infrastructure such as retention/detention basins and bioswales. This work is part of the FEMA funded Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP)'s Leveraged Gray / Green Infrastructure projects and is scheduled to be completed in Fall 2024.
