



Project Update: St. Roch Drainage Upgrade
July 28, 2023

NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

The City of New Orleans Department of Public Works contractor, Command Construction Industries, LLC in conjunction with Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans will begin work in your area.

Starting immediately and continuing through the next 30 days crews will be working on the waterline installation on the side streets. Traffic access on N. Villere St. will be minimal and water may be shut off periodically with notice given to perform tie ins.

Sewer work will begin on N. Villere starting next week 8/7 and this utility installation will continue throughout the subsequent 30 days. N. Villere will be completely shut down to traffic in the blocks of N. Villere where crews are working and will open as crews advance past that block.

BEGIN DATE: Friday, July 28, 2023 at 7:00 a.m.
END DATE: Friday, September 1, 2023 at 5:00 p.m.
In general, crews will work between 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.

What residents need to do differently?

As this work is being completed, sections of the roadway will be closed to vehicle traffic due to roadway and driveway removal and replacement for repairs. Signage will be posted. **Driveway access will be restored by Tuesday, September 5th, 2023 at 5:30PM.**

Please move all vehicles off the street before Monday, July 31st, 2023 at 7:00AM. **We ask that residents please adhere to no parking signage on the streets. Vehicles parked in these zones will be ticketed and towed.** Additional notice will be given to residents prior to work impacting driveway access.

U.S. Postal Service and sanitation/recycling services will continue throughout construction; however, depending on conditions in front of your residence you may be asked to take your garbage and recycling bins to the nearest accessible corner on your normal collection days.

About the Project

This temporary disruption of services is part of the \$18.5M and St. Roch Drainage Upgrade joint infrastructure project with the City of New Orleans' Department of Public Works and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans.

Once complete, residents will experience an overall improved quality of life as the project will alleviate flooding by increasing the capacity of subsurface drainage between local streets and trunk lines, as well as by using green infrastructure options which may include retention/detention basins, street basins, rain gardens, and street side bioswales. The project is scheduled to be completed in Fall 2024.
