

French Quarter Infrastructure Improvement Project

The City of New Orleans and Sewerage & Water Board began a \$6M repair of Bourbon Street surface and underground infrastructure as part of the Citywide Public Safety Improvement Program on April 24, 2017. Work will take approximately nine months to complete.

Temporary Curb Side Use


Full reconstruction of the roadway requires temporary adjustments to curb use. During construction of the French Quarter IIP, expect additional signage and garbage corrals on side streets to facilitate garbage pick-up from 4 am to 10 am and 4 pm to 10 pm, Monday through Sunday.

Existing Freight, Cab and Hack Zones may shift or be temporary eliminated to accommodate construction.



Garbage Corrals

Expect designated Garbage Corrals throughout reconstruction of Bourbon St. Corrals will be identified with paint on the existing asphalt roadway as well as physical barriers. During reconstruction of the 100-300 blocks of Bourbon St.



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
