Capital Improvement Program Highlights

- More than \$2.2B worth of DPW / SWB work
- Most comprehensive infrastructure program our region has seen in a generation.
- More than 200 individual projects every neighborhood will feel a positive impact.
- Multiple Funding Sources: FEMA-funded road / waterline work, FEMA-funded Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) projects, HUD-funded National Disaster Resiliency Competition (NDRC) grant projects, SWB-funded Sewer System Evaluation and Rehabilitation Program (SSERP) (sewer consent decree) work and City-funded bond project work.
- Work will create thousands of construction jobs across the city and <u>maximize</u> economic opportunity for the City's small and disadvantaged businesses.


- Designer: Rahman and Associates, Inc.
- Construction Contractor: Hard Rock Construction, LLC
- Cost: Approximately \$3.8M project
- Schedule: Construction will begin early Feb. 2019 and will be completed in one year.

Types of Construction – What the colors represent

Patch Mill/Overlay

Repave the asphalt roadway from curb to curb and repair damaged sidewalks.

Patch Concrete

Remove damaged portions of the concrete roadway and replace it with new smooth concrete pavement and repair damaged sidewalks.

Incidental Road Repairs

Remove damaged portions of the asphalt roadway and replace it with new smooth pavement.





Types of CIP Construction – What the colors represent

Non-Paving Incidentals

Repair damaged sidewalks, driveway aprons and curbs within the public right-of-way.

Other Group Project

Street is in the design phase or is planned to be built in a future project.


Waterline Replacement or Repairs

Repair sewerage, water, and drainage lines, rebuild the street entirely, and repair sidewalks and curbs.







Typical Roadway Cross-Section



Patch Concrete

- Replacing one or multiple damaged concrete panels in the roadway
- Repairs may be made to some damaged curbs, sidewalks and driveway aprons









Patch Mill / Overlay



- Roadway will be resurfaced with asphalt
- Repairs may be made to some damaged curbs, sidewalks and driveway aprons








Incidental Road Repairs



- Roadway patches will be resurfaced with asphalt
- Repairs may be made to some damaged curbs, sidewalks and driveway aprons








Non-Paving Incidentals



- Eligible damaged or missing sidewalks will be removed and replaced
- New sidewalks meet
 Americans with Disability Act
 requirements







Subsurface Utility Replacements or Repairs

- Drainage line repairs
- Minimal water service disruptions
- Notifications will be sent to residents 48hours prior to any work that may cause water services disruptions







Subsurface Utility Replacements or Repairs

 N. Johnson, between Piety and Desire, and N. Derbigny, between Pauline and Alvar, will require waterline replacements.

 Trenches will be dug for waterline work on N. Johnson and N. Derbigny. Once the utility work is complete the trench sites will be filled. Paving work will follow.







Americans with Disabilities Act-Compliant Curb Ramps

Curb ramps at sidewalk corners ensure accessibility for people who are visually or physically impaired, using wheelchairs or strollers.

What to Expect During Construction

Temporary construction impacts

- Additional construction equipment
- Limited parking availability
- Sounds
- Dust



Efforts to minimize construction impacts

- Construction signage placed around the sites.
- Any temporary closures will be communicated in advance.
- Any changes to garbage and US Postal services will be communicated in advance.
- Residents will be informed throughout construction.

Regular work hours are Monday-Friday 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Permission for occasional weekend work may be granted, if required.





What to Expect During Construction Traffic


- One travel lane will be maintained, in each direction, throughout construction, otherwise.
- Limited parking will be available near trench site.
- Crews will attempt to allow local access to driveways in the evenings.
- One to four crews will be on-site.
