
Capital Improvement Program Highlights

- More than \$2.2B worth of combined DPW / SWBNO work
 - Most comprehensive infrastructure program our region has seen in a generation.
 - More than 200 individual projects every neighborhood will feel a positive impact.
 - Multiple Funding Sources: FEMA-funded road / waterline work, FEMA-funded Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) projects, HUD-funded National Disaster Resiliency Competition (NDRC) grant projects, SWB-funded Sewer System Evaluation and Rehabilitation Program (SSERP) (sewer consent decree) work and City-funded bond project work.
 - Work will create thousands of construction jobs across the city and maximize economic opportunity for the City's small and disadvantaged




Village De L'Est Group B - Overview

- **Timeline:** Project will begin mid July 2019 and will be completed in Fall 2020




Future Project - Village De L'Est Group C

Typical Roadway Cross-Section



Scope of Work

- Repaying the asphalt and concrete roadway from curb-to-curb in some areas;
- Patching the roadway with asphalt in some areas;
- Repairing some damaged sidewalks and driveway aprons;
- Installing American with Disability Act- compliant curb ramp at intersections; and
- Replacing/repairing damaged underground water lines.




Waterline Replacements or Repairs

- Minimal water service disruptions
- Notifications will be sent to residents 48-hours prior to any work that may cause water services disruptions





Patch Mill / Overlay



- Roadway will be resurfaced with asphalt
- Repairs may be made to some damaged curbs, sidewalks and driveway aprons





Patch Concrete

- Replacing one or multiple damaged concrete panels in the roadway
- Repairs may be made to some damaged curbs, sidewalks and driveway aprons



Sidewalks

- Sidewalk panels adjacent to Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)compliant ramps will be replaced with new sidewalks.
- New sidewalks and ramps will meet ADA-compliance regulations.

What to Expect During Construction

Temporary construction impacts

- Additional construction equipment
 - Staging for this project will be near the construction site.
- Limited parking availability
- Sounds
- Dust

Efforts to minimize construction impacts

- Construction signage placed around the sites.
- ✓ Any temporary closures will be communicated in advance.
- ✓ Construction equipment will not be staged in areas that prohibit residential access and
- ✓ Any changes to garbage and US Postal services will be communicated in advance.
- Residents will be informed throughout construction.

Regular work hours are Monday-Friday 7 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Permission for occasional weekend work may be granted, if required.
