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Capital Improvement Program Overview

- This project is part of a \$2.4 billion City-wide, multi-year infrastructure repair/recovery effort.
- The CIP is the most comprehensive infrastructure program our region has seen in a generation.
- The CIP is designed to improve infrastructure throughout the City.
- This program is managed on a neighborhood-by-neighborhood basis.
- Damages were identified by FEMA, the Department of Public Works and through citizen input.
- Includes more than **200** individual projects.

Capital Improvement Program Overview

- **Multiple Funding Sources:** FEMA-funded road / waterline work, FEMA-funded Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) projects, HUD-funded National Disaster Resiliency Competition (NDRC) grant projects, SWB-funded Sewer System Evaluation and Rehabilitation Program (SSERP) (sewer consent decree) work and City-funded bond project work.
- Aggressive project schedules coordinated to minimize construction-related impacts.
- Work will create **thousands** of construction jobs across the city and maximize economic opportunity for the City's small and disadvantaged businesses.

Planned Construction

Village D'Lest construction is split into three construction contracts.


1. Village De L'Est Group A (PMOI) – Start Nov. 2017, 15 months duration
2. Village De L'Est Group B (PMOPC) – Scheduled start - Spring 2018
3. Village De L'Est Group C (FRC) – Scheduled start - Fall 2018

This first project is valued at approx \$4.2 M


Total combined value of approx \$20 M

Village De L'Est Group A Planned Construction

- Designed by Stanley Consultants, LLC
- Construction will be performed by Hard Rock Construction, LLC
- Approximately \$4.2 million project
- Construction will begin in Mid-November 2017 and last through the spring 2019



Scope of Work

Patch Mill / Overlay: Repave the asphalt roadway from curb to curb and repair damaged sidewalks.

Incidental Road Repairs: Remove damaged portions of the asphalt roadway and replace it with new smooth pavement.

Non-Paving Incidentals: Repair damaged sidewalks, driveway aprons and curbs within the public right-of-way.

Patch, Mill and Overlay



Before

- Roadway will be re-surfaced with asphalt
- Repairs may be made to some damaged curbs, sidewalks and driveway aprons



After

Incidental Road Repairs



- Roadway patches will be re-surfaced with asphalt
- Repairs may be made to some damaged curbs, sidewalks and driveway aprons



Non-Paving Incidentals



- Eligible damaged or missing sidewalks will be removed and replaced
- New sidewalks meet Americans with Disability Act requirements



Americans with Disabilities Act- Compliant Curb Ramps



Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)-compliant curb ramps at sidewalk corners ensure accessibility for people who are visually or physically impaired, using wheelchairs or strollers.

Construction Sequencing

Staging

Construction equipment will be staged at 7500 Adventure St.

Phasing/Sequencing

- Phase 1: Work will take place in the northern portion of the project bounded by I-10 and Lake Forest during the first four months
- Phase 2: Work will take place between the Lake Forest Blvd. and Dwyer Road and will last seven months
- Phase 3: Work will take place between Dwyer Road and Chef Mentuer Hwy And will last about six months

Construction Sequencing

Schedule

- Mobilization – Mid-November 2017
- Construction End – Spring 2019

In general:

- Three crews working progressively with a minimal number of sites open at one time
- Work will be performed Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

* All schedules are subject to change and weather dependent.

Michoud Blvd. Reconstruction Project

(Chef Menteur Hwy – Dwyer Blvd.)

Michoud Blvd. Reconstruction Project is approximately 22 percent complete.

Last month construction crews installed several new sewer and drainage manholes at the intersection of Lourdes St. and Michoud Blvd.

Construction is scheduled to last through Spring 2018.



What to Expect During Construction

Temporary construction impacts

- Additional construction equipment
- Limited parking availability
- Sounds
- Dust



Efforts to minimize construction impacts

- ✓ Construction signage placed around the sites.
- ✓ Any temporary closures will be communicated in advance.
- ✓ Any changes to garbage and US Postal services will be communicated in advance.
- ✓ Residents will be informed throughout construction.

Regular work hours are Monday-Friday 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.
Permission for occasional weekend work may be granted, if required.




RR188: Village De L'Est Group B (PMOPC)
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
